

## Materials List for Painting with Oils or Acrylics w/Janet Winston

### **Paint colors:**

Cadmium red med.  
Perm. Rose or quinacridone rose  
Cad. Yellow dark  
Cad. Yellow med.  
Hansa yellow light  
Chrom. Oxide green  
Phthalo green or viridian  
Ultramarine  
Ultramarine violet (opt.)  
Cobalt blue  
Cerulean blue  
Yellow ochre  
Raw sienna or light red (opt.)  
Burnt umber or Sepia  
Raw umber  
Payne's grey  
Titanium white (large tube)

Your choice of brands for oils or acrylics.

### **Brushes:**

Bristle brushes in a variety of shapes & sizes, preferably  
1" flat  
¾" and 1" filbert  
#4 round  
#4 black sable, or red sable (more expensive) for fine lines (opt.)

Turpenoid natural or odorless Turpenoid for oil painters  
Paper palette pad or palette for mixing (a pad works well for traveling)  
Oil painting medium (small bottle, for oil painters only)  
Rags or paper toweling  
Palette knife (opt.)  
Plastic containers for water (acrylic painters)  
2 or 3B pencil, white plastic eraser  
Small sketch book or paper

Oils: bring a small to medium sized stretched canvas

Acrylics: bring either canvas or heavy weight paper or even mat board
